Wyoming Inn offers fun fall elk bugling eco tour, great lodging value

Jackson Hole, Wyoming – The haunting calls of bugling elk ring through the Tetons each fall, peaking from September 10 – October 10 as the bulls round up and protect their harems, bears briskly forage in anticipation of coming hibernation, and the changing leaves create a colorful backdrop for the busy wildlife. The Jackson-based [Wyoming Inn](#) offers guests the opportunity to experience nature's dramatic fall show with a family-friendly four-hour Sunset Expedition through the Greater Yellowstone Geo-ecosystem with the experienced biologist/guides of [Wildlife Expeditions](#), a division of nonprofit Teton Science Schools. The adventure is part of a two-night Wyoming Inn Elk Bugling Package that allows wildlife watchers to take advantage of times of day when animals – including the boisterous elk – are at their most active before returning to the Inn's home-away-from-home comforts including bedtime warm cookies with milk.

The Wyoming Inn Elk Bugling Package for two includes the Wildlife Expeditions four-hour Sunset Expedition for two in a customized, safari-style vehicle with retractable roof hatches and sliding windows for optimal viewing opportunities and accompanied by a biologist guide, and two nights accommodations for two in Queen/Queen or King room, including:

- Complimentary breakfast each morning of your stay
- Complimentary shuttle service from the airport, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily
- Heavenly style pillowtop beds for a great night's sleep
- Free snacks available all day
- Warm cookies and milk for a cozy finish to the day each evening

The package rate for two nights lodging for two adults inclusive of the [Sunset Expedition](#) starts from \$790 until October 3, when rate changes to \$590 for off-peak-season extra value. The Wyoming Inn Elk Bugling Package rate varies depending on size and make-up of family groups; Fireplace, King-Fireplace-Jacuzzi-Kitchen rooms and extra nights are available on request. Conveniently located on the town's free START Bus Shuttle Route, the Wyoming Inn is just minutes from the shopping, restaurants and cultural attractions of downtown Jackson.
