10 ideas from the Wyoming Inn for making your vacation a hit with the kids

2. Laurance S. Rockefeller Preserve: Drive out Teton Village road to Grand Teton National Park for a visit to this new Preserve’s state-of-the-art green [interpretive center](#) – and a great easy hike from the parking lot to pristine Phelps Lake.
3. Grand Teton Visitor Center in Moose: Check out the floor in the new [Craig Thomas Discovery and Visitor Center](#) for a surprise; and find “best hikes for kids” on the “best” lists around the 3-D topo map.
4. Bicycling: Set up a [bike tour](#) with Hoback Sports through the historic town center and out to the Elk Refuge – flat terrain!
5. [Yippy I-O Candy](#): Check out this old-fashioned sweets shop on the Town Square by Snake River Grille. All kids big and little love candy.
6. [Billy’s Giant Burgers](#): Also, on the Town Square, offering giant hamburgers (and hand-cut waffle fries).
7. [National Museum of Wildlife Art](#): See original work from Dr. Seuss’s *The Lorax* on view this summer – and stop in the Children’s Discovery Room for fun wildlife-related activities (as well as viewing real wildlife roaming the wild habitat around the building).
8. Wild West adventure: Witness the exciting [Jackson Hole shootout](#) reenactment; free show occurs nightly at 6 p.m. on historic Town

Square. For more Old West fun, try an authentic [stagecoach ride](#) around downtown Jackson.

9. [Wagon Train Dinner](#): Enjoy real-West Jackson Hole history while traveling by wagon train to a Dutch-oven dinner and cowboy show; let the Wyoming Inn arrange the experience as part of your stay.
10. [Snow King Alpine Slide](#): Slide down Snow King Mountain, winding 2,500 feet through forest and wildflowers; relax afterwards with a round of [Alpine Mini Golf](#).
